## **LLM Legal Professional Practice**

### **Course information**

This course is a stepping stone for non-law graduates to go on to qualify for a career in law and will give you a practical edge in the employment market. ### **Eligibility requirements**

Any undergraduate degree from a UK or Irish university or its equivalent in any discipline with a minimum of a 2.2 classification or its equivalent. Students without a 2:2 honours degree from the UK or Republic of Ireland must evidence that they meet the academic entrance requirements of the relevant professional body. Applicants who do not hold a UK first degree must obtain a Certificate of Academic Standing from The Bar Standards Board if they wish to qualify as a barrister.
