Eligibility requirements

Applicants must have a qualifying law degree awarded by a SRA approved provider with at least second-class honours that must include having adequately passed assessments in the seven Foundations of Legal Knowledge: Public Law, Obligations I (Contract), Obligations II (Tort), Criminal Law, Land Law, Equity and Trusts and Law of the European Union, or if you're a non-law graduate, a Graduate Diploma in Law (GDL) or Common Professional Examination (CPE) having obtained overall average marks 50% or above.

All LPC applicants must fall within the SRA's transitional arrangements.
